# BACKGROUND

- General attitude related to patient involvement in clinical trials increased rapidly during the past few years (e.g. EUPATI)
- Active patient advocacy groups and experience experts in HUS (adults)
- HUS is a beneficiary of c4c which includes patient and public involvement (PPI)
  - Setting up Young Person's Advisory Groups (YPAGs) in Europe as a part of PPI activities
- $\rightarrow$  YPAG Helsinki to be set up





## YPAG HELSINKI

- Active patient advocacy groups in different specialty areas in HUS
  - Consistency between different groups: training, processes, reimbursement
  - Will be adjusted to be suitable for young people
- Setting up YPAG Helsinki still in progress in HUS
  - The aim is to fulfill both eYPAGnet and HUS criteria

May 2019: eYPAGnet meeting

Aug 2019: Meeting with HUS lawyer and patient advocacy coordinator

Oct 2019: meeting with a larger group in HUS (different advocacy group representatives, lawyers, patient advocacy coordinator etc.)

Oct 2019: eYPAGnet meeting

# TARGET GROUP

- Group size approx. 10
- Age: 15 to 18 years in the beginning, "easy start"
  - legal differences 14yo vs. 15yo
  - more independent
  - better skills in English language?
- Gradual expansion of the target age when the YPAG starts running smoothly
